

Game Day Procedures

The measures below have been implemented to minimize middle school game day challenges. Please do your best to follow the guidelines during the next game day to ensure the safety of all league participants.

1. All teams should be on the same sideline away from all spectators. The only people that should be on the sideline are players and coaches. The referee will not start the game until both teams are on the same sideline and the sideline is clear of any spectators.
2. It is the home team's responsibility to ensure that all spectators are in the appropriate location.
3. Coaches are responsible for controlling their own players. If you notice that one of your players is playing to aggressive or is using profane language it is your responsibility to hold those players accountable even if it hasn't been brought to the refs attention.
4. If any opposing player needs to use they restroom, the must be escorted by an adult or a student from the home team.

Field Lining: Please continually check your field to ensure the lines are still visible. If the lines are fading, you are responsible for going over your lines with paint. Please call Sean (202.393.6999 x313) if you need paint. Do not wait until the day of a game!!

TAKE NOTE OF UNIFORM POLICY: All players must wear shinguards, uniform, athletic shorts/pants, socks, and athletic shoes.
